Kumi Kata - Method of grasping opponent; Grip	Tachi-Waza - Standing techniques
Kodokan - Judo Headquarters in Tokyo, Japan	Ne-Waza - Ground techniques
Hajime - Start; begin	Mate - Wait; stop
Sore made - Time had expired	Migi - Right
Idari - Left	Ippon - Full point
Ashi - Leg	Shido - Penalty
Kuzushi - Breaking opponent's balance	Uchi Komi - Practicing form by repeating technique many times with partner
Uke - Person who is being thrown	Tori - Person who does the throwing
Sonomama - As it is (stop as you are)	Yoshi - Resume Action
Shido - Penalty	Hansoku-make - disqualification

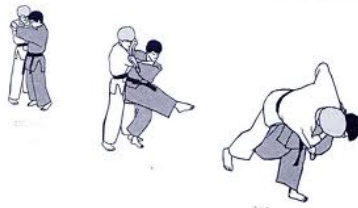

Ne Waza turnovers

Uke is on his hands and knees, tori turns Uke over by grabbing Uke's arms from underneath Uke, pushing Uke with the chest, and placing the arm closer to the head under Uke's head, the other hand between Uke's legs, and performs Yoko Shiho Gatame.

Removing a leg from between Uke's legs
